

OBJECTIVES

The Population Research Centre (PRC), Srinagar has the following broad objectives:

1. To provide an independent and objective assessment of the working of various National Health and Family Welfare programmes/schemes and their impact on the Health Sector of Jammu & Kashmir;
2. To conduct research in population sciences; and assist the MoHFW and the UT Government with policy inputs and feedback on population and health issues;
3. To regularly evaluate and monitor the National Health Mission (NHM), and other health and family welfare programmes and Schemes;
4. To conduct Large Scale Pan-India Demographic and Health Surveys including National Family Health Survey (NFHS) and Longitudinal Aging study of India (LASI); and
5. To streamline and validate the Health Management Information System (HMIS) of the country in general and Jammu & Kashmir in particular.

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
