## **Conferences Organized During 2022-23:**

Population Research Centre in collaboration with the Indian Association for the Study of Population organized the Northern Regional Conference of the Indian Association for the Study of Population at the University of Kashmir on the theme of "Population, Development and Health in Northern India: Status and Challenges Ahead" during 29-

30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. The conference was instrumental in bringing together social scientists working on population and health across India.

By exploring various population and Health issues, i.e., Family Planning, Reproductive and Sexual Health, Morbidity, Nutrition, Population ageing, Migration, Urbanization, COVID-19 and Data Quality issues, this conference pinpointed the current scenario and causal relationship of population, health and development. Along with this, it also gave an outline of efforts to improve in all these areas in the future. The Conference was attended by more than 40 delegates across India and 40 local participants also participated in the deliberations of the technical sessions. There were 3 plenary 62 sessions and 8 Technical sessions. Around 40 research papers were presented during the two-day conference.
